

*I Can Predict Your Employment Future!*

**Maryland's Industry and Occupational Projections** are developed in the Office of Workforce Information and Performance and provide an overview of expected changes in the economy.

**Short-Term Projections:** A 2-year estimation on Maryland's economy. Short-term projections are produced by industry and occupation.

**Long-Term Projections:** A 10-year estimation on Maryland's and Maryland Workforce Regions' economy. Long-term projections are produced by industry and occupation.

Projections estimates employment change (job creation), job replacement (jobs available due to a worker permanently leaving an occupation), and total openings (employment change + job replacement).
