


MID MARYLAND WIA COMMUTER SHED

Where WIA Residents Are Employed

- In 2010, an estimated 208,665 Mid Maryland residents were employed in primary wage and salary jobs.
- Nearly one-third of WIA residents were employed in the workforce area; Baltimore and Montgomery counties were frequent out-commuting locations.
- About 92% of the WIA residents worked in Maryland; the District of Columbia was the next most common state for employment.
