

Where WIA Residents Are Employed

- In 2010, an estimated 71,339 Upper Shore residents held primary wage and salary jobs.
- About 48% of the WIA residents were employed in the Upper Shore; another 12% commuted to jobs in Anne Arundel County.
- Easton was the most common city or place for employment of WIA residents, followed by Cambridge and Baltimore City.
