

**Where WIA Residents Are Employed**

- In 2010, an estimated 98,023 Western Marylanders were employed in primary wage and salary jobs.
- About 58% of the residents worked in the tri-county area; another 9% commuted to Frederick County.
- Nearly 87% of WIA residents held jobs in Maryland; West Virginia and Pennsylvania were work destinations for another 9%.
