**Where WIA Workers Live**

- In 2010, an estimated 63,583 workers were employed in wage and salary jobs in the tri-county Lower Shore WIA.
- Nearly 7 out of every 10 workers employed in the Lower Shore also resided there.
- About 86% of area workers were Maryland residents; almost 9% commuted from Delaware, with Sussex County providing the largest number of in commuters from the state.
