Where WIA Workers Live

- An estimated 436,743 primary wage and salary jobs were located in Montgomery County in 2010.
- About 47% of the workers holding county jobs lived in Montgomery, with Prince George's home to another 11% of the county's workforce.
- More than 8 out of 10 Montgomery workers were Maryland residents; another 7.8% of county workers came from Virginia.
