


Where WIA Workers Live

- The Upper Shore WIA was location to an estimated 52,489 primary wage and salary jobs in 2010.
- Nearly two-thirds of workers holding area jobs resided in the Upper Shore.
- Nine out of ten Upper Shore workers were Maryland residents; Delaware contributed about 6% of the area's workforce.
