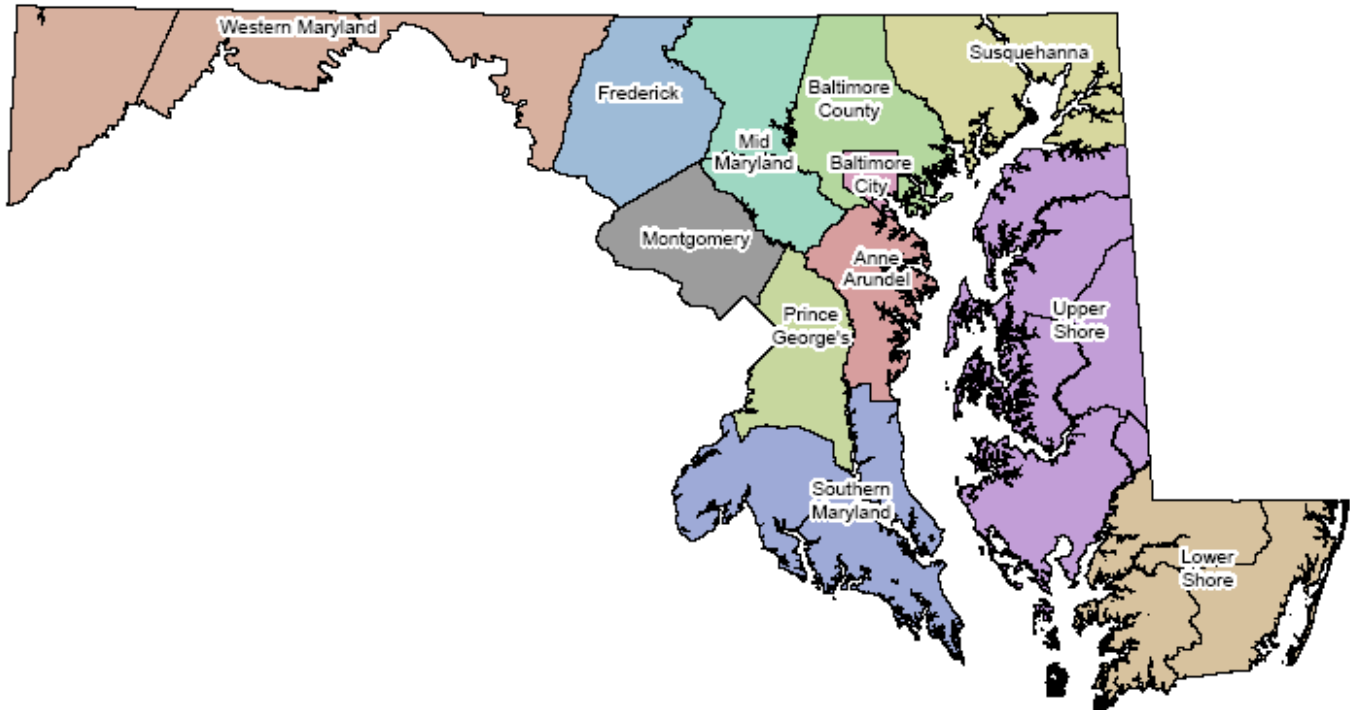


Map of Maryland's Workforce Investment Areas

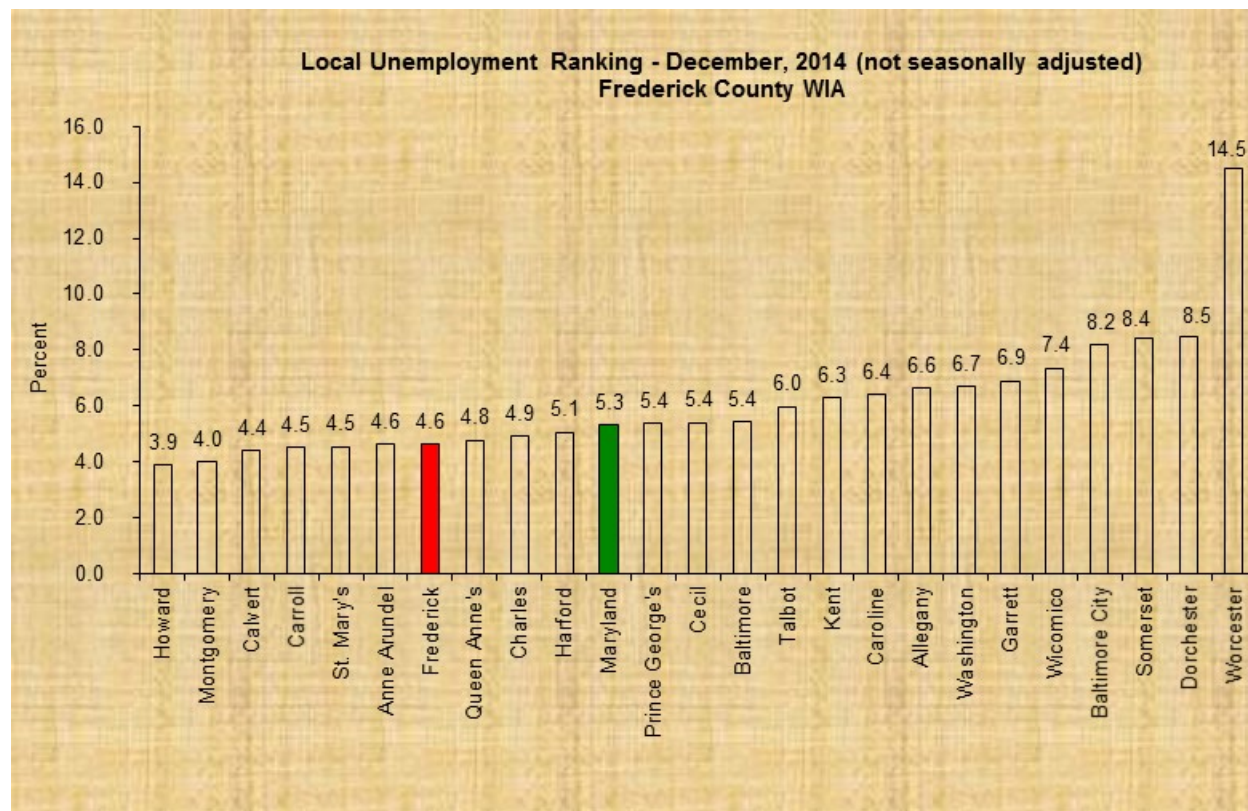

Frederick County Workforce Investment Area (Frederick County WIA) is a single county workforce investment region. It comprises communities within the county.

There was drop in the labor force during the period from November to December of 906 people for a rate of change of -0.7%. The employment level dropped off at a slightly sharper rate of 0.8% that included 955. The level of those unemployment jumped by 0.8% with an additional 49 people being estimated as out of work. There was absolutely no effect on the non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate as that remained unchanged at 4.6%.

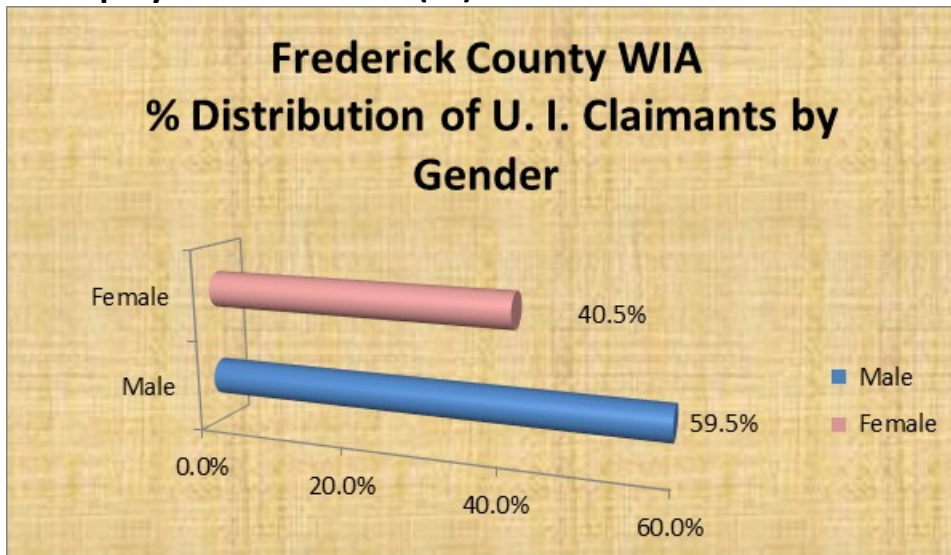

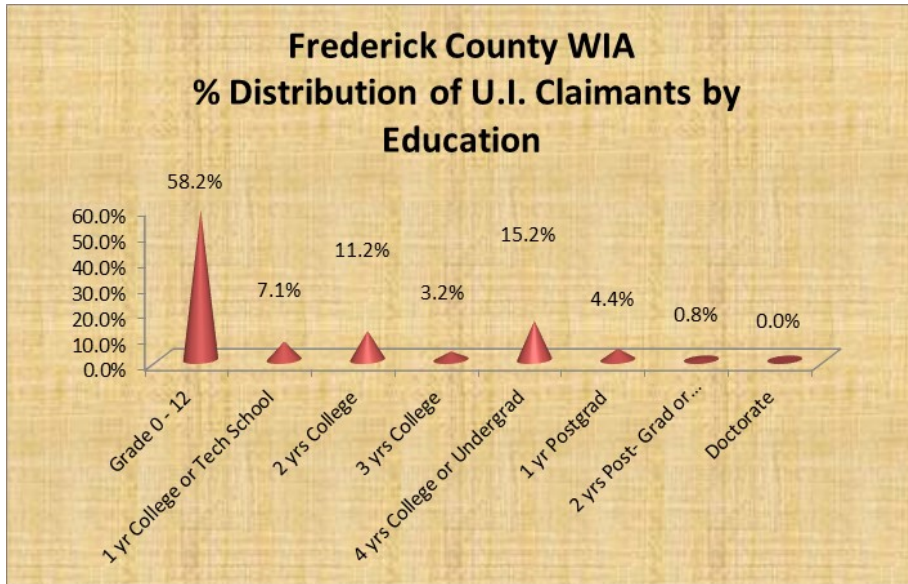

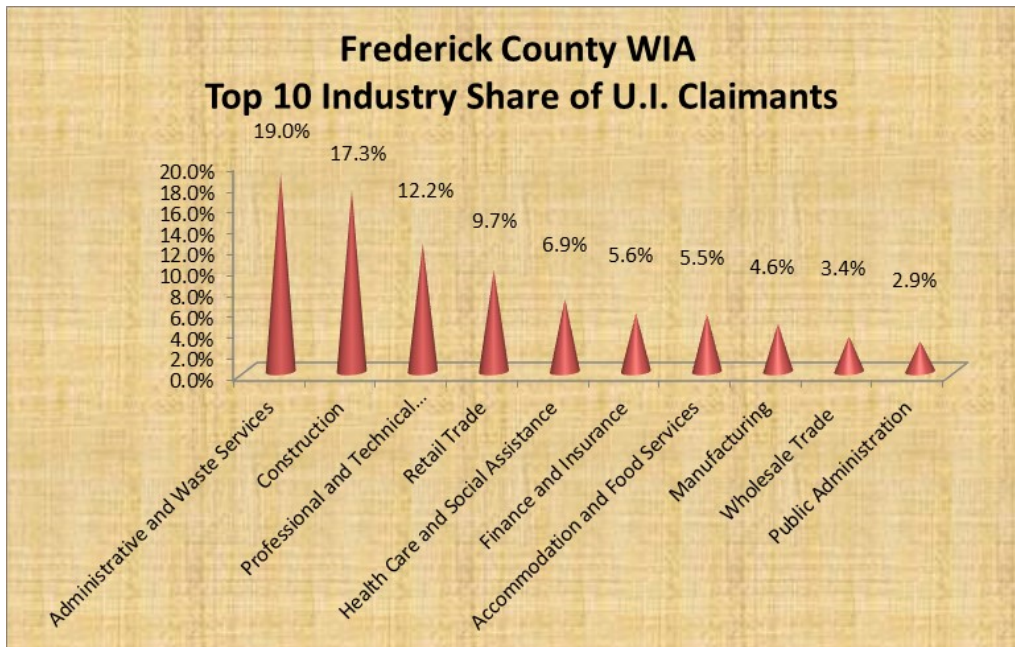

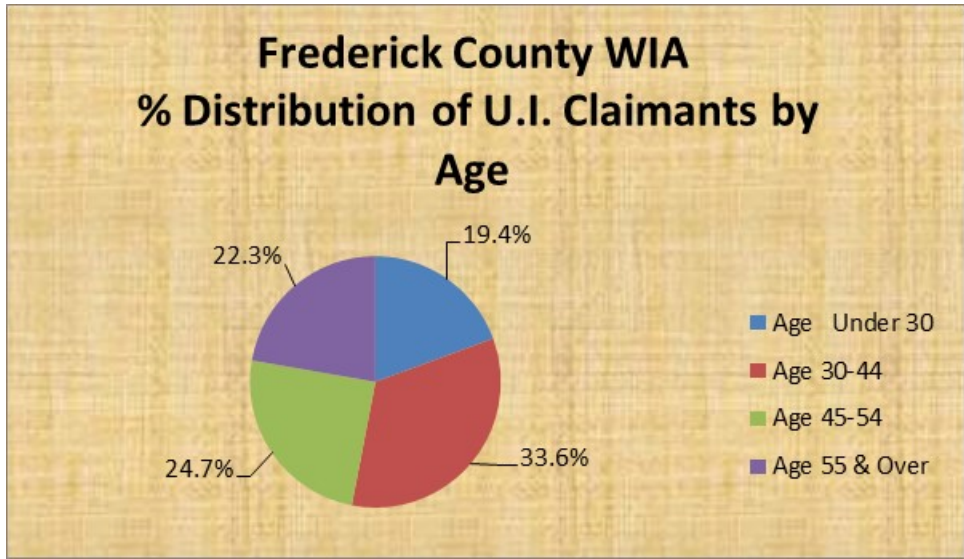
