


Map of Maryland's Workforce Investment Areas




Mid- Maryland Workforce Investment Area (Mid-Maryland WIA) is a multi county workforce region. It is comprised of Carroll and Howard Counties.

The labor force in this area slipped by 1,239 residents for a monthly rate of decline of 0.5%. The number of those who were employed declined also, but by 0.4% as a result of losing 1,071 people in December. Those who were unemployed was reduced by 168 for a rate of change of -1.5% from last month. There was no effect on the non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate as that remained unchanged at 4.1%.



Unemployment Insurance (UI) Continued Claimants








