

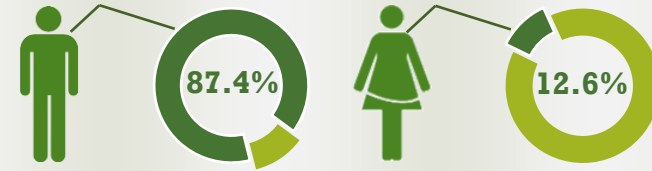

Maryland Veteran Population

Women make up 12.6% of the veteran population. That is over 46 thousand veterans. Men have the lion's share of the population, with an 87.4% share.
