

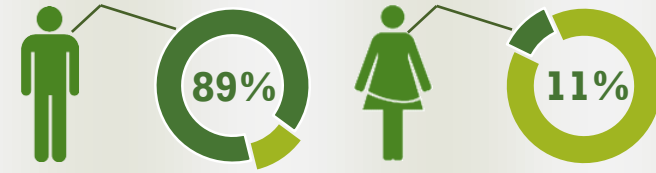

## Population of Maryland's Veterans

 **403,900**  
Veterans in Maryland

**29.2%**  
The largest veteran age group, 35 to 54 years old



Women make up over 11% of the veteran population. That's over 46,500 veterans. Men have the lion's share of the population, with an 89% share.

-  **76,125** Gulf War (9/2001 or later)
-  **95,270** Gulf War (8/1990 to 8/2001)
-  **127,657** Vietnam era
-  **35,644** Korean War
-  **25,269** World War II


**14.6%** St. Mary's County contains the largest share of Maryland veterans.

**Over 63%** Annapolis is the city with the largest share of Maryland veterans.

## Veteran Employment Outlook

**5.6%** Unemployment Rate for Maryland Veterans

**83%** Maryland Veterans who are employed or actively seeking employment.

 **35.2%** Maryland veterans with a Bachelor's degree or higher.

## Veteran Disability

There is a larger share of Maryland Veterans who are disabled vs Non Veterans who are disabled.

Disabled Veterans **21.5%** vs Disabled Non Veterans **12.6%**
