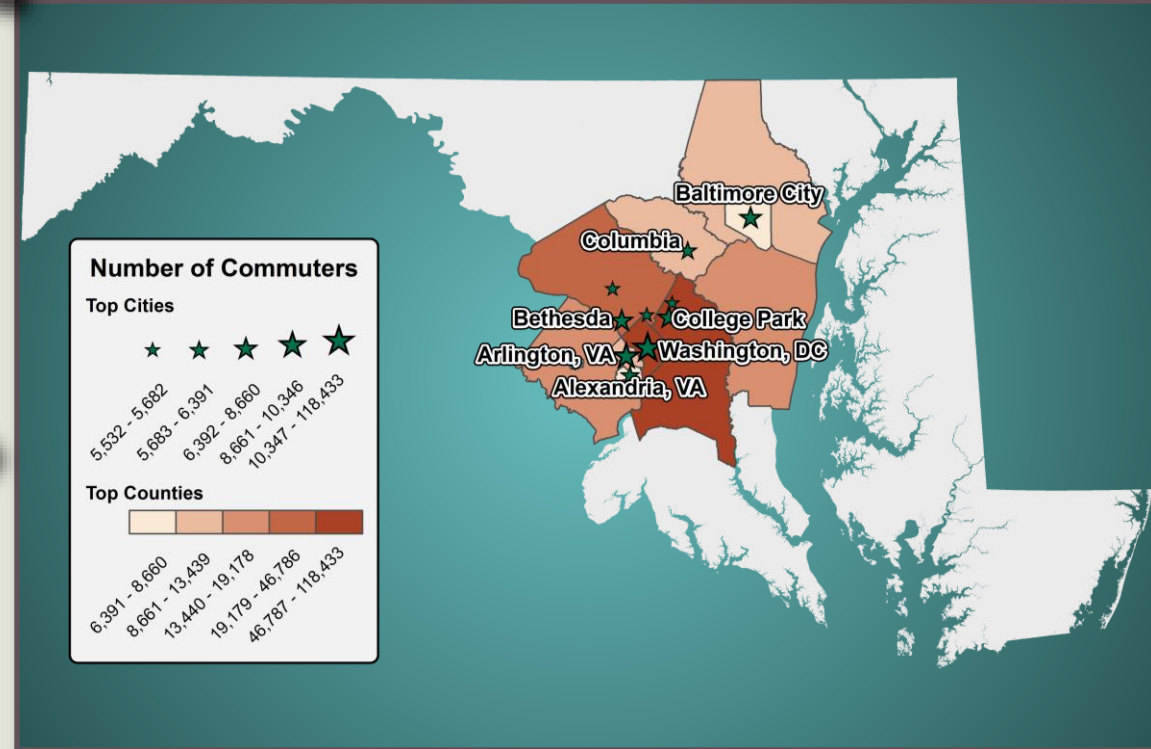
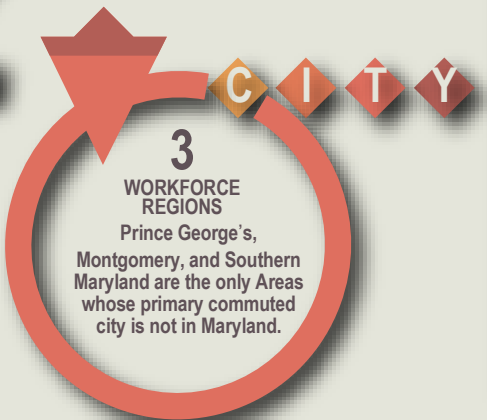
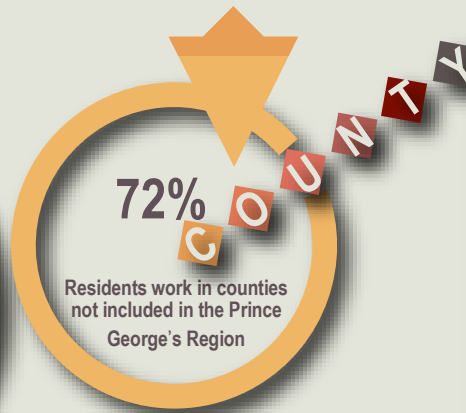
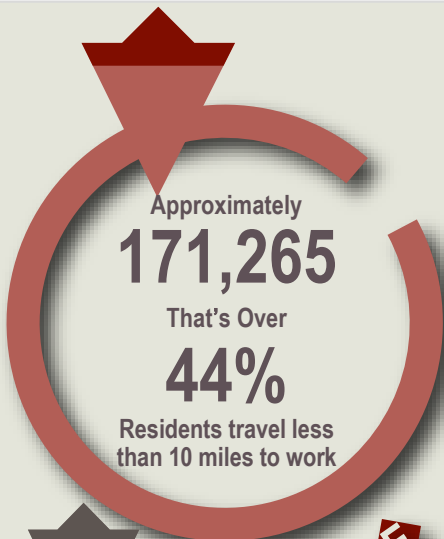


Commuting Patterns: Prince George's Workforce Region

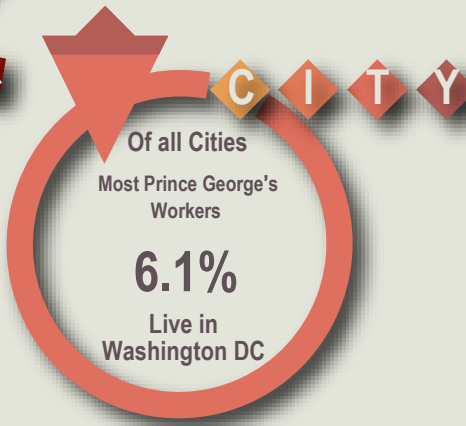

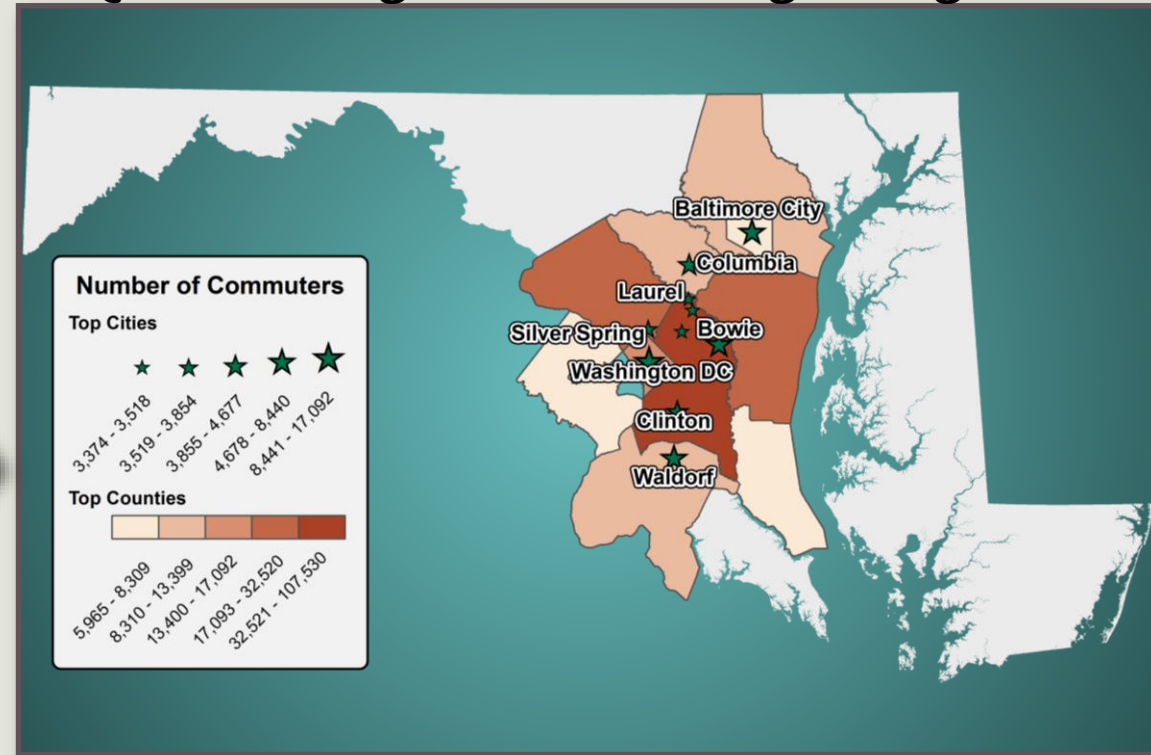
