


## AVERAGE QUARTERLY INDUSTRY EMPLOYMENT BY COUNTY (SECOND QUARTER 2015)



### DID YOU KNOW?

- Under the Local Employment Dynamics (LED) Partnership, Maryland shares QCEW data with the Census Bureau as input for Quarterly Workforce Indicators (QWI) dataset. The QWI Explorer (available at: <http://qwiexplorer.ces.census.gov>) provides access to labor-force indicators such as employment, job creation and destruction, wages, and hires across a wide range of firm and worker characteristics.

### HOW IS QCEW DATA USED?

- | Evaluate the economic health of the labor market
- | Calculate state revenue projections
- | Determine the employment base of states
- | Ascertain the unemployment insurance (UI) covered employment

### HOW CAN I USE QCEW DATA?

- | Find current levels in payroll employment by industry
- | Assist locating job openings and labor turnover for an industry
- | Use the data to find the geographic concentration of an industry through cluster mapping
